
Application Notes



- DP Application: December 7, 2017
- DP Application process included:
 - 737 addresses notified of DP Proposal
 - 44 responses: 43 opposed, 1 in favour
 - Heritage Designation became condition of DP as result of the public notification
 - Review by Vancouver Heritage Commission with Support
- RM-5 Zoning
- Heritage Designation permits consideration of regulatory relaxations, in this instance for a parking relaxation from four spots to one carshare spot


Site and Surrounding Zoning

Heritage Significance:

- Built in 1907 by Thomas J. Lightheart
- Reflective of West End
 neighbourhood evolution
- Edwardian-era details
- Excellent Condition

Heritage Recognition:

- Currently listed as a 'B' property on the Vancouver Heritage Register
- Proposed to become municipally designated ('M')
 - Protected by by-law
 - Heritage Alteration Permit required for exterior changes
