Dear Mayor and Council,

I was on the speakers list to speak to the rezoning of 3600 & 3680 E Hastings St a few days ago, but after waiting over 3 hours to speak to this item, I had to leave due to my work obligations.

I hope you can include my comments in your decision:


- Good evening Mayor and Council
- My name is Pawel Szydowski and I am here today to support the proposal for 3600 & 3680 East Hastings Street. As this project was introduced to the community concurrently, I would like my comments to be taken this way as well.
- As a renter and young working professional, finding rental housing is difficult to find in Vancouver, especially in the Hastings Sunrise Area.
- As a life long resident of East Vancouver, renter and current resident of Hastings Sunrise, I hope to see this project go forward.
- Since moving to the Hastings Sunrise area many years ago, I've been waiting for better dining and retail options in my neighbourhood.. Along the Cassiar Corridor, many stores have closed - which could be a factor of insufficient population in the surrounding areas to support local businesses. We need more rental and affordable housing to keep our neighbourhood vibrant.
- I especially appreciate that this proposal also offers moderate income units, which will help to keep young working professionals like myself in Vancouver. It also aids single parent families and lower-income families being able to afford to live close to employment opportunities in Vancouver and Burnaby. Unfortunately, many people are being pushed out of the city in search of more affordable housing..
- The project is in a very desirable location. With the new addition of the R5 B-line bus, it will be in an ideal location for transit users and commuters who frequent to Burnaby, the North Shore or Downtown Vancouver.

- I really hope to see this project approved tonight; I think it would be a great addition to the neighbourhood – I think this is a great opportunity for our community along the last end of Hastings to flourish!
