SUBJECT: Text Amendment: Simplified and Expanded Zoning and Development Regulations for Passive House Projects

In response to the concerns raised in the letter to Council from the Vancouver Character House Network, I would like to note that:

- The proposed amendments are only available to high performance buildings which have numbered between 2 and 10 homes per year, so we do not expect a material impact on character home building stock.
- The proposed incentive, which provides approximately 4% of building area for a single family Passive House, is less than the bonus density for character retention at 6% of building area and therefore should not compete with it.
- One incentive does not preclude the other. The proposed incentive for Passive House can be paired with the character incentives. If an applicant retrofitted their character home, they could access both incentives.

I hope that this information provides a helpful perspective and allows public hearing to proceed efficiently.
