

**EXPLANATION****A By-law to amend the Vacancy Tax By-law No. 11674  
Regarding Late Declarations**

Enactment of the attached By-law will bring into effect Council's decision of May 12, 2020 to approve amendments to the Vacancy Tax By-law to change the date to which extensions for late declarations can be granted and to allow for late declarations for the 2017 and 2018 vacancy reference periods, except that the final date for extensions has been changed from the first business day of July, which Council was initially erroneously advised was the property tax deadline, to the second business day of July, which is the correct property tax deadline.

BY-LAW NO. \_\_\_\_\_

**A By-law to amend the Vacancy Tax By-law No. 11674  
Regarding Late Declarations**

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in public meeting, enacts as follows:

1. This By-law amends the indicated provisions of the Vacancy Tax By-law No. 11674.
2. In section 6.3(a), Council strikes out "except that no such extension will be granted beyond December 31<sup>st</sup> of the year in which the tax is due and payable" and substitutes "except that no such extension will be granted beyond the second business day of July of the year after the year in which the tax is due and payable, except for the 2017 and 2018 vacancy reference periods where an extension may be granted until December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2020".
3. A decision by a court that any part of this By-law is illegal, void, or unenforceable severs that part from this By-law, and is not to affect the balance of this By-law.
4. This By-law is to come into force and take effect on the date of its enactment.
