## COUNCIL MEMBER'S MOTION

## 2. Establishing Fairness for Standing Committee Chairs and Agendas

WHEREAS the Standing Committee Chairs are currently appointed by Council annually and do not get increased remuneration for the extra duties associated with the position;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT staff bring back by-law changes to the *Procedure By-Law* 9756 section 13.2, that the Chair for the Standing Committees be rotated yearly to reduce the burden of chairing within a minority council. This would start in 2020 with Councillors Fry and Kirby-Yung as Chairs with Vice-Chairs Councillors Bligh and Hardwick, in 2021 with Councillors Bligh and Hardwick as Chairs with Vice-Chairs Councillors Wiebe and Dominato, and in 2022 with Councillors Wiebe and Dominato as Chairs with Vice-Chair Boyle for both committees to ensure governance capacity is met and that there is fairness across all Deputy Mayors;

FURTHER THAT the Chair and Vice-Chair be involved in an agenda review with relevant staff prior to each meeting to ensure meeting effectiveness.

## CURRENT BY-LAW

Standing Committee Chair 13.2 The Chair at each meeting of a standing committee is to be:

- (a) a member of that committee appointed by Council annually to be the Chair; or
- (b) in the Chair's absence, a member of that committee appointed by Council annually as the Vice-Chair; but in the Chair's or Vice-Chair's absence when the City Clerk calls the meeting to order, the standing committee may choose a member of that committee to serve as the Chair, as its first item of business after roll call
