EXPLANATION

A By-law to Amend Street Vending By-law No. 10868 Regarding Amendment to Patio Definitions

The attached By-law makes a minor amendment to the Street Vending By-law to remove the current restriction of patios to food service establishments. This minor amendment will allow any business in the City of Vancouver to apply for a small patio on public property. This is a permanent change to the By-law and will allow non-food service businesses to apply to use public space on a permanent basis if the General Manager of Engineering Services approves.

A By-law to amend Street Vending By-law No. 10868 Regarding Amendment to Patio Definitions

THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF VANCOUVER, in public meeting, enacts as follows:

- 1. This by-law amends the indicated provisions of the Street Vending By-law.
- 2. In section 1.2, Council:
 - (a) amends the definition of "small patio" by striking out "food vending".

3. A decision by a court that any part of this By-law is illegal, void, or unenforceable severs that part from this By-law, and is not to affect the balance of this By-law.

4. This By-law is to come into force and take effect on the date of its enactment.
