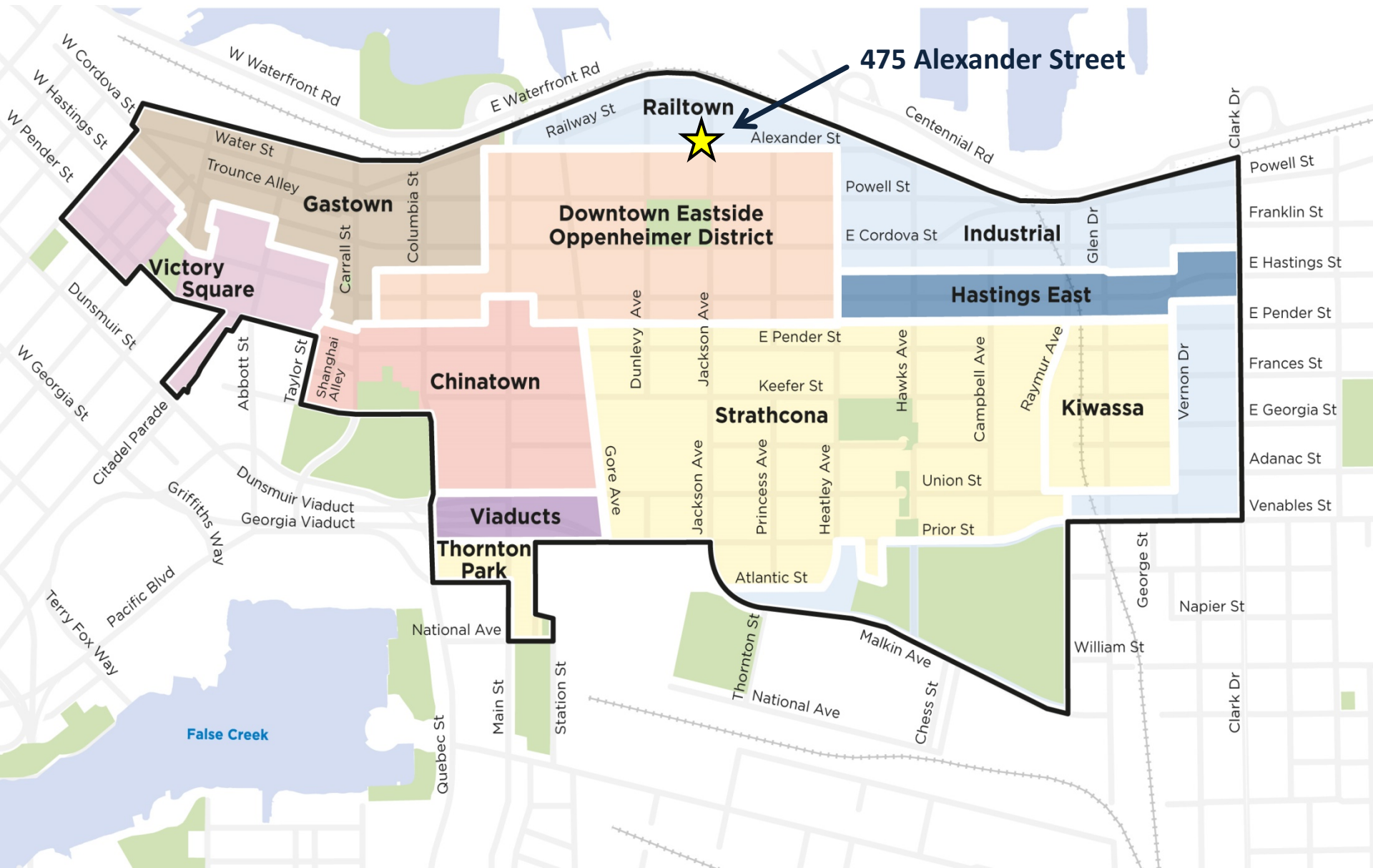

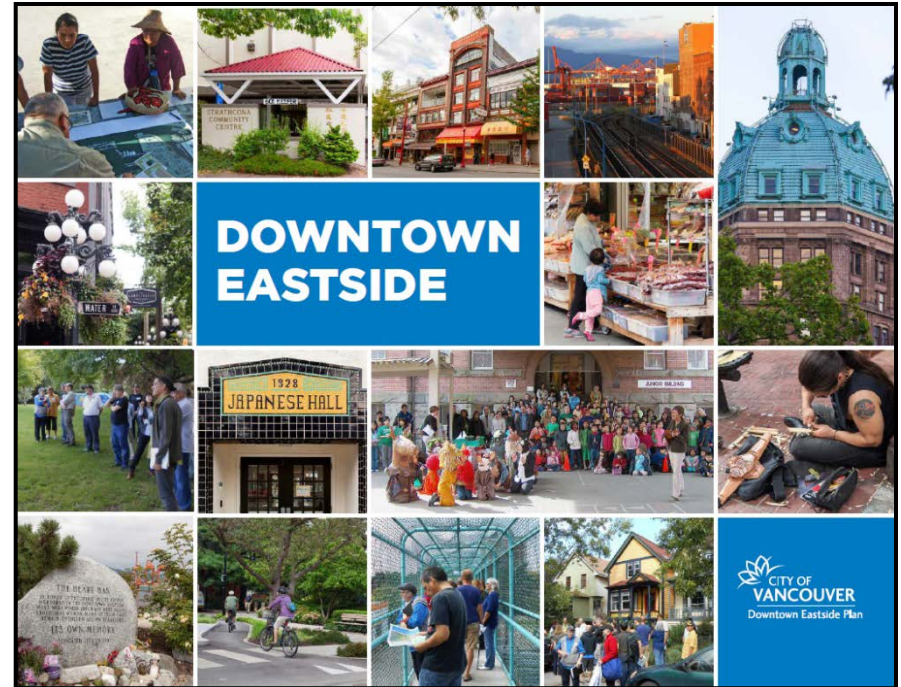
Moments In History

- 1906** ● Japanese Language School was founded.
- 1928** ● The 1928 Japanese Hall building was constructed.
- 1942** ● Japanese Canadians were interned and the Canadian Government expropriated their properties.
- 1953** ● The Japanese Canadian Community returned and the school was restored and reopened.
- 1995** ● Site was rezoned to CD-1 (337).
- 2000** ● The 2000 Japanese Hall building was constructed.
- 2019** ● Granted a National Historic Site by Federal Government.
