The first being a serious shortage of rental accommodation, a matter of some concern because my income was from a part-time job at first. Vancouver has had an ongoing challenge to provide decent homes for low and moderate income households to this day and this is a special concern for households dealing with health conditions that may result in income variations. This plan to add 154 units of various sizes is an important step in the right direction, especially since there will be 2 and 3 bedroom units for families, whose housing needs are not met often enough. The second issue 41 years ago was that the Vancouver Gay and Lesbian Community Centre was a very new organization. I became member #48. At the time, VGLCC operated out of a living room in the Commercial Drive area. It is heartening to see that VGLCC has morphed into Qmunity and that the City is supporting the organization to have a clear presence as a service organization. The City is to be congratulated on its role in this development.
