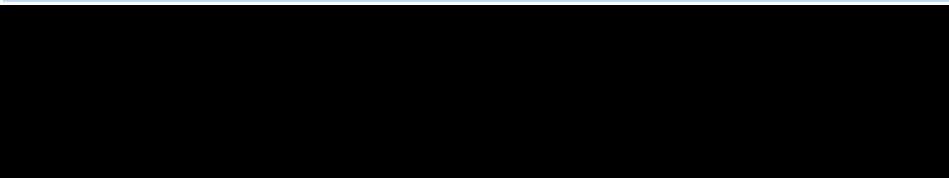

The project is too large for a low barrier supportive housing building. BC Housing's own guidelines call for supportive housing buildings to be 40 - 50 units max. Given the suggested wording of the housing agreement, the building could be all or mostly low-barrier; there is no guarantee that 50% of the building will be for those renting at or below 50% HILs. Too little information has been provided on what supports will be available. I am very concerned that there will be inadequate supports to help the tenants and to minimize disorder on the neighbourhood considering BC Housing's track record. The city has not done enough to address safety issues for the residents of this neighbourhood that include many young families.

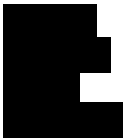

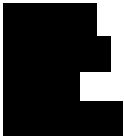
