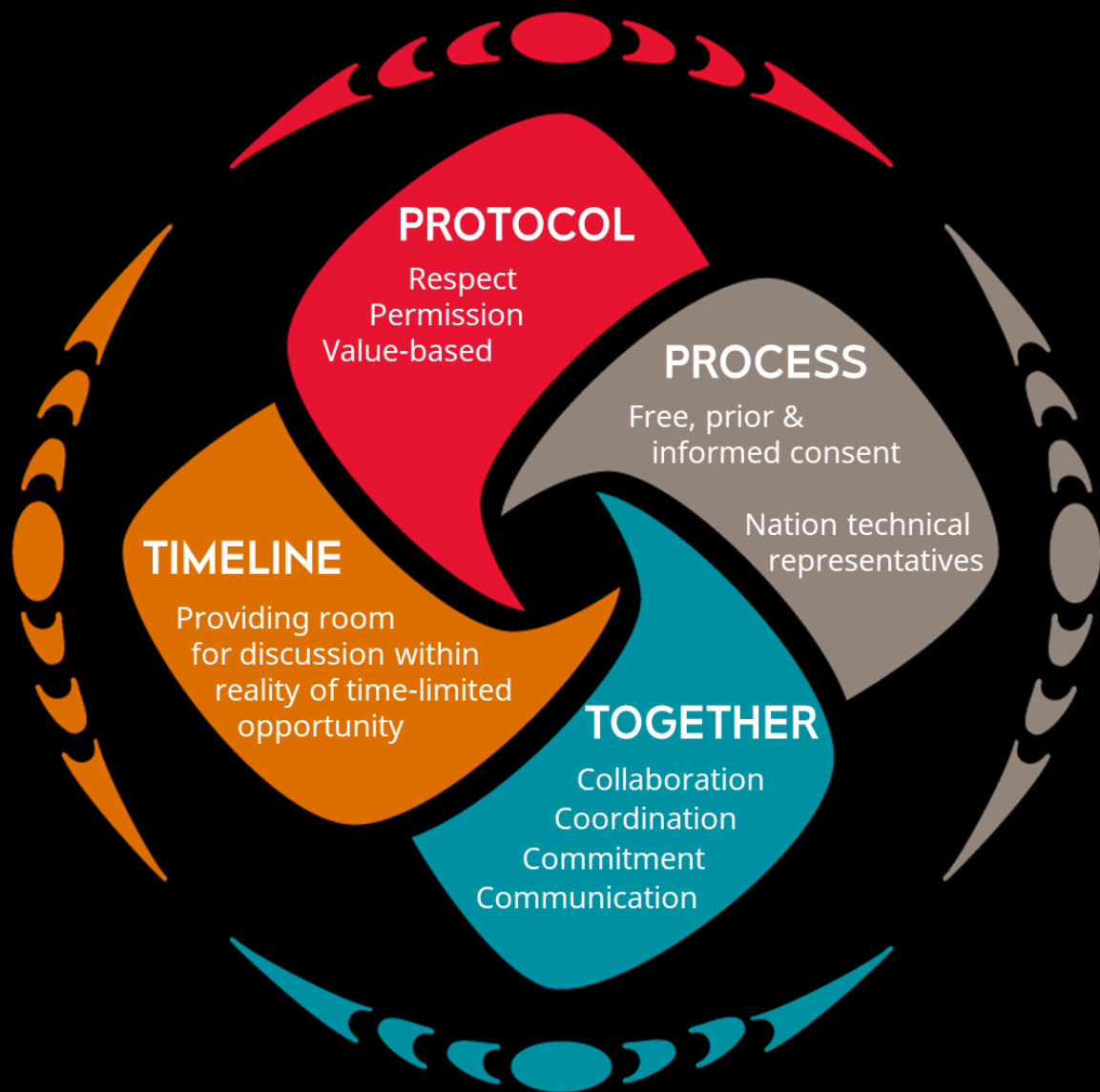

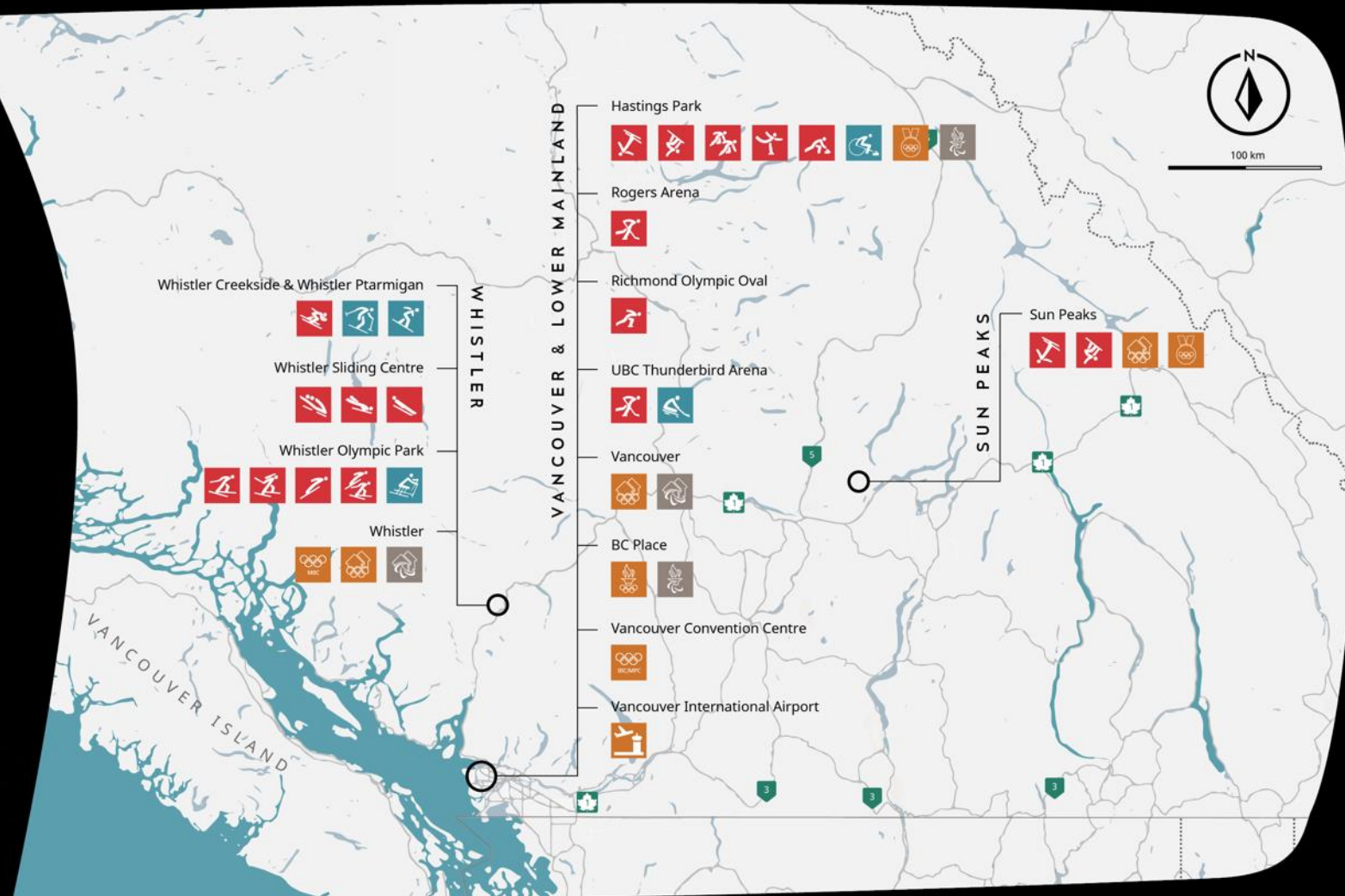

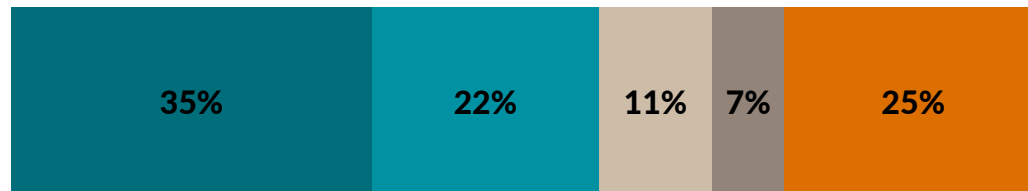
ENGAGEMENT TO DATE



To what extent does the concept statement for a 2030 Olympic and Paralympic Winter Games personally resonate with you?

The concept is resonating a lot or very highly with 57% of respondents and to some degree or better with 75% of respondents.

Community Engagement Survey Results cont'd

- “Thinking back to 2010 Games” sentiment towards the Games 73% positive, 10% neutral
- Legacy pillars and proposed outcomes are all positively rated, between 4.86 and 5.52 out of 7 in terms of being meaningful goals

Approximately 2,000 direct engagements (in person or virtual) across several activations in the region so far

- Overwhelmingly positive at 90+ %

Feedback includes

- Intrigued by Indigenous-led and reconciliation focus; “It’s time”
- Supportive of venue re-use plan and climate-positive
- Concerns re: impacts – cost, affordable housing legacy, transportation plan, over-tourism

3. Letters of support and/or minutes or resolutions of Indigenous governing bodies and local government councils

GAMES CONCEPT REQUIREMENT

- Use in-kind of Pacific Coliseum, Agrodome, Racecourse, Amphitheatre and Hasting Park
- Use in-kind of Trout Lake, Killarney and Northeast False Creek arenas
- Temporary road closures to support Games operations
- Approvals and utilities needed for Olympic and Paralympic Vancouver Village

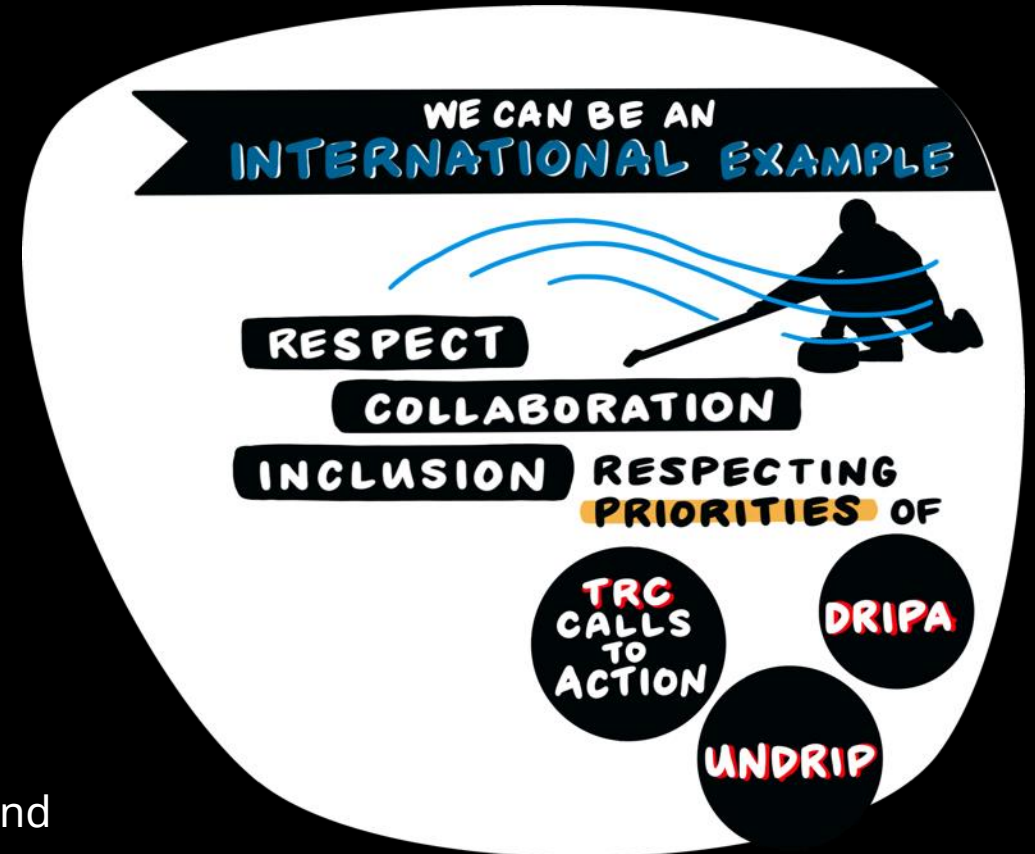

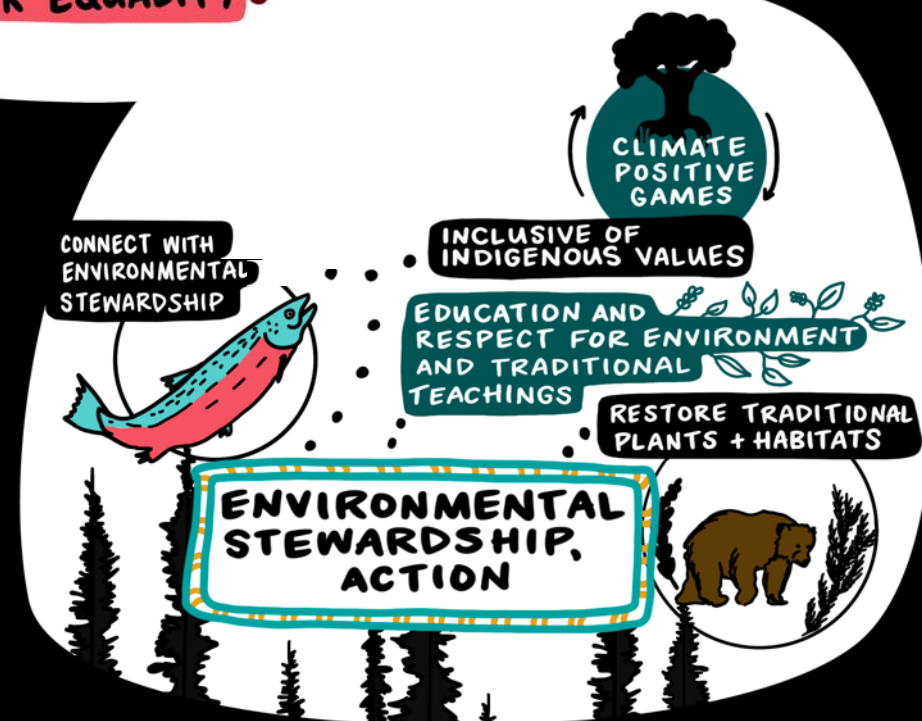

DIRECT BENEFITS

- Nation to Government relationship building
- \$3B+ spend in region of outside dollars
- \$5 come into region from outside sources for every \$1 of investment from public entities in BC
- Capital upgrades to community venues, incl. accessibility and environmental
- Increased tourism, jobs, community profile
- Ability to leverage Games to attract sponsor or partner funding for municipal priorities

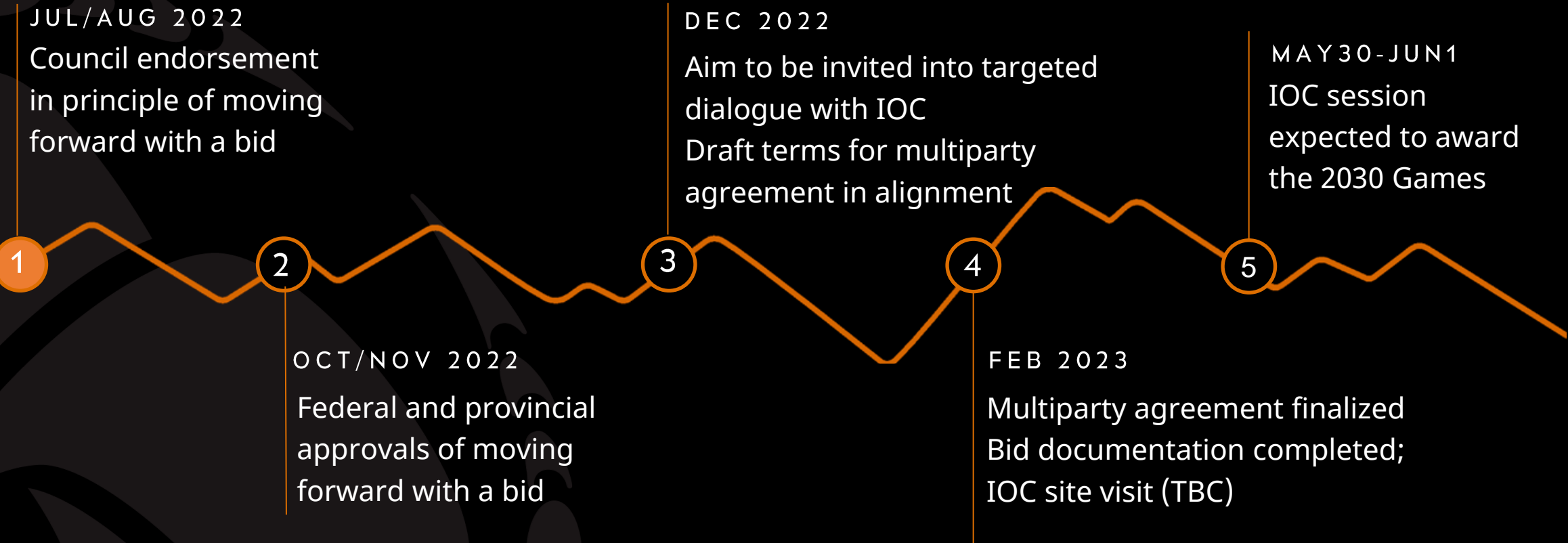
