SUBJECT: Vancouver Civic Theatres Rental Rates 2023-2024

RECOMMENDATION

A. THAT Council approve the recommended rental rates and fee increases for commercial licensees, which are outlined in the Summary of Commercial Rental Rates for Vancouver Civic Theatres that is attached to this report as Appendix A.

B. THAT Council approve the recommended rental rates and fee increases for notfor-profit organizations, Theatre Rental Grant recipients, and VCT Grant recipients, which are outlined in the Summary of Not-for-Profit and Grant Rental Rates for Vancouver Civic Theatres that is attached to this report as Appendix B.

REPORT SUMMARY

This report seeks Council approval of fee increases of four percent (4%) for commercial licensees that license the use of Vancouver Civic Theatres (VCT) locations during the performing arts season that will run from September 1, 2023 to August 31, 2024. The specific licence fees that VCT will charge commercial licensees are outlined in the Summary of Rental Rates for VCT that is attached to this report as Appendix A.

This reports seeks Council approval of fee increases of three percent (3%) for not-for-profit organizations, Theatre Rental Grant recipients, and VCT Grant recipients that license the use of VCT locations during the performing arts season that will run from September 1, 2023 to August 31, 2024. The specific licence fees that VCT will charge these types of licensees are outlined in the Summary of Rental Rates for VCT that is attached to this report as Appendix B.

COUNCIL AUTHORITY/PREVIOUS DECISIONS

On July 9, 2019 (RTS 12991) Council approved new rental rates for VCT that included both commercial and not-for-profit rental rates for three consecutive seasons from September 1, 2020 to August 31, 2023.

On May 17, 2022 (RTS 14874), Council approved 42 Theatre Rental Grants totalling \$1,190,865 for the period of Sept. 1-Dec. 31, 2022 and 57 Theatre Rental Grants totalling \$1,830,685 for the period of Jan 1-Aug. 31, 2023.

CITY MANAGER'S/GENERAL MANAGER'S COMMENTS

The City Manager recommends approval of the foregoing.

REPORT

Background/Context

Rental rates are adjusted each year prior to the preparation of the annual operating budget. Adjustments are made effective September 1st of each year in alignment with the traditional performing arts season. Rental rates are set annually in relation to the specific economic factors, such as general inflation, cost, and labour increases, the City's budget objectives, and in relation to the local, regional and national market.


Strategic Analysis

Rental Rates

Commercial rental rate increases at Vancouver Civic Theatres' large capacity venues – the Queen Elizabeth Theatre (QET) and Orpheum – allow for subsidization of VCT's smaller capacity, community-based venues – the Annex and the Vancouver Playhouse – where the rents are lower than their operating cost.

The rental rates are set based on inflationary increases related to operational cost increases and are reviewed in relation to those of comparable facilities to ensure that VCT's rates are appropriately placed according to local, national, and international markets. Figure 1 below is an example that shows a gradual and consistent increase over the past eight years for commercial and not-for-profit single performance rental rates at the QET, a premiere performing arts centre that books both not-for-profit and commercial operators.

Staff are recommending a four percent (4%) increase for commercial rental rates and a three percent (3%) increase for all not-for-profit, TRG, and VCT Grant rental rates for the 2023/2024 (September 1, 2023 to August 31, 2024) season, per Appendix A and Appendix B.

Rates outlined in Appendix A and Appendix B have been reviewed by the VCT Board and they recommend the rates for approval by Council. In preparation for a potential increase, all booking enquiries received for the 2023/2024 season have been informed of a potential rental increase pending Council approval. If Council approves the 2023/2024 rental rates, a confirmation letter will be sent to all of regular users of VCT to confirm these rates.

Vancouver Civic Theatres Facility Fees

Ticketing companies charge facility fees directly to patrons attending events at Vancouver Civic Theatres and remit this fee to VCT. The fee, net of administrative costs (15%), is transferred to

the capital facility reserve for capital maintenance of the theatres. For the 2023/2024 Season, staff are recommending an increase of 25 cents per ticket sold to Commercial, not-for-profit, TRG, and VCT Grant Licensees. The facility fee price structures are listed in Appendix A and Appendix B.

Financial

The rental rate increase will impact revenues from September 1, 2023 until August 31, 2024. The approved rates will be used for the 2023 and 2024 operating budget process.

Figure 4 below, shows an estimated overall increase in rate related rental revenue of approximately \$184,210 for the 2023/2024 Season.

Rental rate increases are necessary to account for annual increases in labour and other operating costs, and to continue to subsidize the below operating cost rates for the Vancouver Playhouse and the Annex that ensure these venues remain accessible to the arts and culture sector.

CONCLUSION

This report proposes an increase in VCT rental rates of four percent for Commercial Licensees and three percent for not-for-profit, TRG, and VCT Grant Licensees for the 2023/2024 performing arts season effective September 1, 2023 to August 31, 2024, as detailed in Appendix A and Appendix B.
