CD-1 Rezoning: 1925 Southeast Marine Drive	Support	<p>I support the rezoning of this site (currently undeveloped) for 72 supportive-housing, shelter-rate studio apartments, with BC Housing providing the funding for both construction (with \$3.5M from CMHC) and operation.</p> <p>If this housing is blocked, the provincial and federal funding goes elsewhere, but the people who would have lived there don't vanish: they end up living in parks or on the streets.</p> <p>Under the terms of the July 2020 agreement between the city, BC Housing, and CMHC, BC Housing is responsible for selecting tenants and providing funding to the operator.
