With that being said, I'm writing today to oppose the proposal for a 5-storey apartment building at 2126 West 34th Ave, 5025 Arbutus Street and 2109-2129 West 35th Ave. There are three main reasons why I am opposed to the development at this specific location and they're all related to safety (specifically potential safety issues based on past history and the potential for safety issues in the future). The first safety concern I have is that specific corner/turn/jog on Arbutus between 33rd Ave and 36th Ave has experienced one death and multiple accidents over the past 5 years. Unfortunately, drivers take the turn above the speed limit on a regular basis and regrettably, we had a young man lose his life going northbound on Arbutus street (just off of Quilchena Cres) a few years ago. We've also had multiple vehicles "hop the curb" because they lose control of their vehicles while driving too quickly or the road conditions are less than ideal (Arbutus street is either wet from rain or has ice on it) and cars lose traction and fishtail or hydroplane. I'm concerned that with the potential development of these sites, there will be an increase in vehicles on the road and there will potentially be more accidents and injuries in the future along that corner/turn/jog. The second safety concern I have is regarding the triangular intersection on the corner of Arbutus and Quilchena Cres. There are a number of drivers who don't follow the rules of the road and enter and exit that intersection in the wrong direction. I'm concerned that with the potential addition of more vehicles from the development, that intersection is going to become even more problematic/treacherous than it already is now. I've personally been involved in several near misses while driving because people are confused and don't know how to use the intersection.
