While I fully understand the urgent need for more density and new models of housing what is being proposed on this street is a drastic and unfitting change. One of the houses, 2349, was a heritage era Kerrisdale farmhouse. Lorraine and David Stuart purchased the property circa ten years ago. They gutted the house and did an extensive renovation. It is a beautiful home now sitting vacant and surrounded by majestic trees. I feel that this house should not be torn down to clog our landfill. It could be repurposed and incorporated into a new design with added townhomes, duplexes and apartments. This would increase density and somewhat maintain the flavour of Kerrisdale. But the biggest concern I have regards infrastructure and traffic. Many of the houses on the street do not have garages and park on west 49th.
