SUBJECT: Rezoning: 5515 Elizabeth Street – Amendment to Subdivision By-law

Following referral of the above item to Public Hearing on October 17, 2023, Council approved amendments to the Zoning and Development By-law which consolidates nine RS residential zones by rezoning areas zoned RS-1, RS-1A, RS-1B, RS-2, RS-3, RS-3A, RS-5, RS-6 and RS-7 to a new R1-1 Residential Inclusive zone (RTS 15854).

This application proposes that the zoning change from RS-1 (Residential) District to CD-1 (Comprehensive Development) District, with the above RS consolidation to the current zoning for the site which is now R1-1 (Residential Inclusive) District.

The Summary and Recommendations have been updated to reflect the change in zoning to R1-1 (Residential Inclusive) District and no further action on this yellow memorandum is required by Council. To approve the rezoning application, Council must approve the Summary and Recommendations
