Tanner alley is a t-junction between Tanner & Price. Elementary school in next door to proposed site on Tanner St. Infrastructure is not there. There are 8+ laneway houses in the short alleyway. Cars are parked in alleyway often making one barely able to drive through. Condos and new apartments are built/being built on Joyce St causing traffic jams. Correlation between low cost housing with crimes and drugs are high. With the school kids next door, it will promote higher societal problems.
