Dear Mayor and Council,

A resolution passed by Council at the Council Meeting following the Standing Committee on Policy and Strategic Priorities on October 23, 2024, had an administrative error with respect to the Metro Vancouver appointments. The City of Vancouver has 34 votes, while the resolution approved by Council totalled 35 votes as follows:

In order to correct this administrative error, it is recommended that Councillor Meiszner, who replaced Councillor Carr as a Director, be allocated the 4 votes previously assigned to Councillor Carr.

As the recommended motion would be an amendment to a previously adopted resolution, under section 8.13(4)(b) of the *Procedure By-law*, a Council member who voted with the majority for this resolution on October 23, 2024, would need to move the amended motion. The following Council members voted with the majority (in favour) for this resolution on October 23, 2024: Mayor Sim and Councillors Bligh, Dominato, Kirby-Yung, Klassen, Meiszner, Montague and Zhou. Please note, that Councillors Carr and Fry voted in opposition. Any member may second the motion and all members present at the meeting at which the vote occurs are eligible to vote.

In conclusion, it is recommended that City Council amend the previously adopted resolution of October 23, 2024, to correct the administrative error as discussed in this memorandum.
