### Pilot Overview

- Public Procurement
  - May 2023 December 2023
- Pilot Launch
  - January 4th 2024
  - District 1 and District 2
  - Traffic Enforcement
- Pilot Completion
  - June 30th 2024
- Vancouver Police Board
  - November 21st 2024
- Vancouver City Council
  - November 26th 2024



#### **Pilot Results**

- Public survey showed 88% supported the VPD operating a BWC program.
- Internal Surveys showed 73% of operational members supported a BWC program.
- With members participating in the BWC Pilot, 92% were in support of a BWC program.



### Post Pilot Engagement

- We have spoken with the Indigenous Advisory Committee (IAC), SisterWatch, Sexual Orientation Gender Diversity Committee (SOGD), and the Squamish Public Safety team.
- All committees support a full BWC program.
- Expectation from each committee was for each officer in a marked police uniform to be equipped with a BWC.



### **Option Two**

- Three options presented in the evaluation report.
- Vancouver Police Board approved option 2 on November 21st.
  - Deploy 812 personally assigned BWCs to frontline members.
  - Deploy 169 pooled BWCs to investigative and administrative members.
  - Total of 981 BWCs being deployed.
  - This hybrid model would utilize both personally assigned and pooled cameras.

#### **Option Two**

- This option satisfies councils motion to deploy BWCs to all frontline police officers by the end of 2025.
- Based on feedback from post pilot engagement it resolves the gap that members outside of Operations that work uniformed callouts would be equipped with a BWC.
- Cost:
  - \$6.57M in 2025
  - \$5.11M in 2026
  - \$5.26M in 2027



# Implementation Plan

- Rollout would begin in Q2 of 2025.
- Training in Q2 will utilize Cycle 2 training dates and will include:
  - Patrol Districts 1-4
  - Metro Teams
  - BET Teams 1-4
  - Traffic Enforcement
  - Marine Unit
  - Gang Crime Unit
  - Canine Unit
  - Emergency Response Unit



# Implementation Plan

- Training in Q3 and Q4 2025 will include:
  - Recruits,
  - Experienced Officers,
  - Investigative and
  - Administrative Sections.
- Full deployment achieved by the end of 2025.
