Close calls are a near-daily occurrence, especially at 6th Ave where drivers ignore the newly-installed "no left turn" signs or attempt to cross all 6 lanes of Main St while traveling on 6th Ave. Recently completed developments have already added several hundred new residents and workers to the area and this project will add several hundred more. There are potentially thousands of additional daily trips occurring here compared to just a few years ago, increasing the odds of conflicts and putting people at risk. We need real traffic calming measures yesterday and certainly before this project is completed. Signage is not enough please consider physical barriers to turning movements and (an) additional signalized crossing(s) between 2nd and Broadway.
