one of the best transit-connected locations in the entire region, sitting directly at the intersection of the Expo and Millennium SkyTrain lines and along a major cycling route. If we can't build dense, mixed-use housing here, then where can we?

This kind of infill development is essential climate policy. Locating homes where people can easily walk, cycle, and take transit reduces car dependence, lowering greenhouse gas emissions and improving air quality. It curbs urban sprawl, protecting farmland and natural ecosystems from further encroachment. Concentrating growth in places like this makes our city more sustainable and more resilient in the face of the climate crisis.

The inclusion of a 37-space childcare facility is another major reason to support this project. When my children were younger, we lived very close to this site and spent years languishing on childcare waitlists. They effectively aged out without ever getting a spot. It's a far too common story in this city, and it's a contributing factor to driving women out of the workplace and families out of the city. Every new childcare space is a lifeline for working families.

When we first moved to Canada, this neighbourhood was our home, and we loved it. It's where we built our first community, spent countless hours at Trout Lake and Clark Park, and came to know and appreciate everything Commercial Drive has to offer. Now, though my kids still attend the local elementary school and we spend as much time as we can in the neighbourhood, we were priced out in 2020 and now live in Hastings-Sunrise. But I miss it. I want my kids to have the chance to return to this neighbourhood as adults and be able to afford to live here. Projects like this one make that vision possible.

It's been discouraging to see so much resistance to this project from those lucky enough to have already secured stable housing in this neighbourhood. We're in a worsening housing crisis, and years of delay on this site have only made things worse—driving up costs, deepening inequality, and shutting people out of communities they love. We cannot afford more obstruction from those who “got theirs.” We need to build for the next generation. There must be no further delay.
