Is there any plan to try and stagger construction to minimize disruption for residents?  2) from the plan I see there are less parking stalls than there are units. While I know the hope is that being close to transit will reduce the need for vehicles, I think this is optimistic and not reflective of reality. For every unit without a car there will be a two bedroom with roommates who each have a car. These additional vehicles will end up parking on the street, which is already often at capacity.  Is there a plan to either cap the number of residential permits given the flood of new residents these buildings will create? If not, is there any plan to increase the size of the permit parking area to open up more parking spots?  Will there be any requirement by the city to have the parking spots in the building included in the lease of the units? If not, there have been several buildings where landlords will significantly increase the cost of parking because they cannot increase rent above the government set cap.
