Mid-rise apartment buildings are an important link in the vacancy chain. Tearing them down to build towers, rather than putting towers on land currently occupied by single-family homes, removes options for people looking to live in the city and is a poor use of land. With regards to the concerns raised in the referral report, this building sits at an extremely busy intersection at 12th and Kingsway. There's a 21-storey building two blocks away that has yet to destroy the neighbourhood, and a new SkyTrain station three blocks away. I have trouble taking concerns about height, traffic, and neighbourhood character seriously in this context. Not to mention that the continued NIMBY war against density - which prices people out of Vancouver and forces them to drive back in - is contributing much more to traffic congestion than an 18-storey building close to transit in a walkable neighbourhood.
