

## SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES (BUSINESS LICENCE HEARING)

## **SEPTEMBER 10, 2025**

A Special Meeting of the Council of the City of Vancouver was held on Wednesday, September 10, 2025, at 9:41am, in the Council Chamber, Third Floor, City Hall, for the purpose of holding a Business Licence Hearing to determine whether to deny, grant, or grant with conditions the application made by Keith Rose (the "Applicant") for a 2025 business licence ("Business Licence") for a short-term rental accommodation at 643 E 13<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Unit 2. This Special Council meeting was convened in person and via electronic means as authorized by Part 14 of the *Procedure By-law* and the *Vancouver Charter*.

## **WELCOME**

The Chair acknowledged we are on the unceded homelands of the Musqueam, Squamish, and Tsleil-Waututh People. We thank them for having cared for this land and look forward to working with them in partnership as we continue to build this great city together.

The Chair also acknowledged the City of Vancouver's team members who work hard every day to help make our city and incredible place to live, work, and play.

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Following Roll Call, Councillor Fry rose to declare a conflict of interest under Section 145.2(2)(b) of the Vancouver Charter, due to personal relations with the Applicant.

Subsequently, the Meeting Coordinator, called on Councillor Orr, the Alternate, to the Business Licence Hearing panel, to maintain quorum for the remainder of the hearing. After confirming Councillor Orr's presence, Councillor Fry rescinded the Chair and left the room for the remainder of the hearing.

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Following Councillor Fry's departure, the Meeting Coordinator called upon Iain Dixon, Legal Counsel for the City of Vancouver, to provide remarks.

lain Dixon advised the panel that the Applicant indicated they had not received the evidence package and therefore the Applicant requests the hearing be rescheduled to a future date. Iain Dixon agreed to the rescheduling and recommended that the hearing be adjourned.

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Subsequently, Councillor Kirby-Yung rose on a point of parliamentary inquiry to ask if the panel needed to appoint a Chair before moving a motion to adjourn. The Meeting Coordinator confirmed that the panel would need to move a motion to appoint a Chair for the duration of the proceedings.

Thereafter, it was

MOVED by Councillor Kirby-Yung SECONDED by Councillor Dominato

THAT the Business Licence Hearing panel appoint Councillor Kirby-Yung, Chair for the remainder of the hearing.

CARRIED UNANIMOUSLY

At this point in the hearing, Councillor Kirby-Yung assumed the role of the Chair.
