Vancouver's West End is one of the most walkable, transit-rich neighbourhoods in the country, and it is precisely the kind of location where density makes sense. A 27-storey hotel and long-term stay building in this location is a thoughtful use of an underutilised site — it adds 270 units of accommodation that serves both the tourism economy and longer-term residents who benefit from flexible housing options. The ground-floor restaurant activation also contributes to street life and the broader vitality of Barclay Street. The revised application's reduced height and FSR compared to the original proposal demonstrates the applicant's willingness to work within city policy, which I find encouraging. Vancouver needs more accommodation supply, and projects like this — well-located, transit-adjacent, and mixed-use — are exactly the kind of investment the city should be welcoming.
