On January 23, 2024, Council referred the above-noted rezoning application to a Public Hearing. After referral, staff determined that an additional condition of approval is required to secure the Community Amenity Contribution (CAC). This memorandum recommends an additional condition of enactment to secure the CAC which was inadvertently missed in the Referral Report dated January 9, 2024, titled "CD-1 Rezoning: 1002-1052 Seymour Street and 550 Nelson Street". The applicant has been informed and has provided acceptance of the additional condition of approval.



RECOMMENDATION

THAT the following additional condition of approval be included with Part 2: Conditions of By-law Enactment of Appendix B:

"Community Amenity Contribution

2.3 Pay to the City a contribution of \$379,349 which the applicant has offered to the City. Payment is to be made prior to enactment of the CD-1 By-law, at no cost to the City, and in a form and on terms and conditions satisfactory to the Director of Legal Services. The contribution is to be allocated to support the delivery of public benefits in and around the Metro Core area."

Action is required by Council. This memorandum will form part of the February 27, 2024 Public Hearing agenda package and be available for public viewing.
